

**Tuition and Fees:** \$31,824

**Room and Board:** \$9,380

**Academic Scholarship:** \$5,000-\$17,000 range; competitive full-tuition awards in biology, mathematics, chemistry, neuroscience, psychology, and peace and justice studies

**Jesuit High School Scholarship:** \$2,000 annually for all admitted Jesuit high school graduates; one competitive full-tuition award for a Jesuit high school student

**Financial Aid:** Merit scholarships are awarded at the time of admission with no separate application needed. Competitive full-tuition scholarships are also available. 90% of admitted students receive merit-based financial aid; 69% receive need-based financial aid. The average institutional gift aid package is \$15,000, and the average financial aid package is \$22,900. We offer a four-year graduation guarantee as well as an on-campus job opportunity for each freshman through our Learn and Earn Program. **Application Deadlines and Fees:** Rolling admission—most applications arrive between November and February of senior year. There is no application fee when you apply using the Common Application or our Regis online application.

**Campus Visits:** Throughout the year we offer student-led tours of campus and meetings with our admission counselors. Consider an individual visit or one of our special events.
